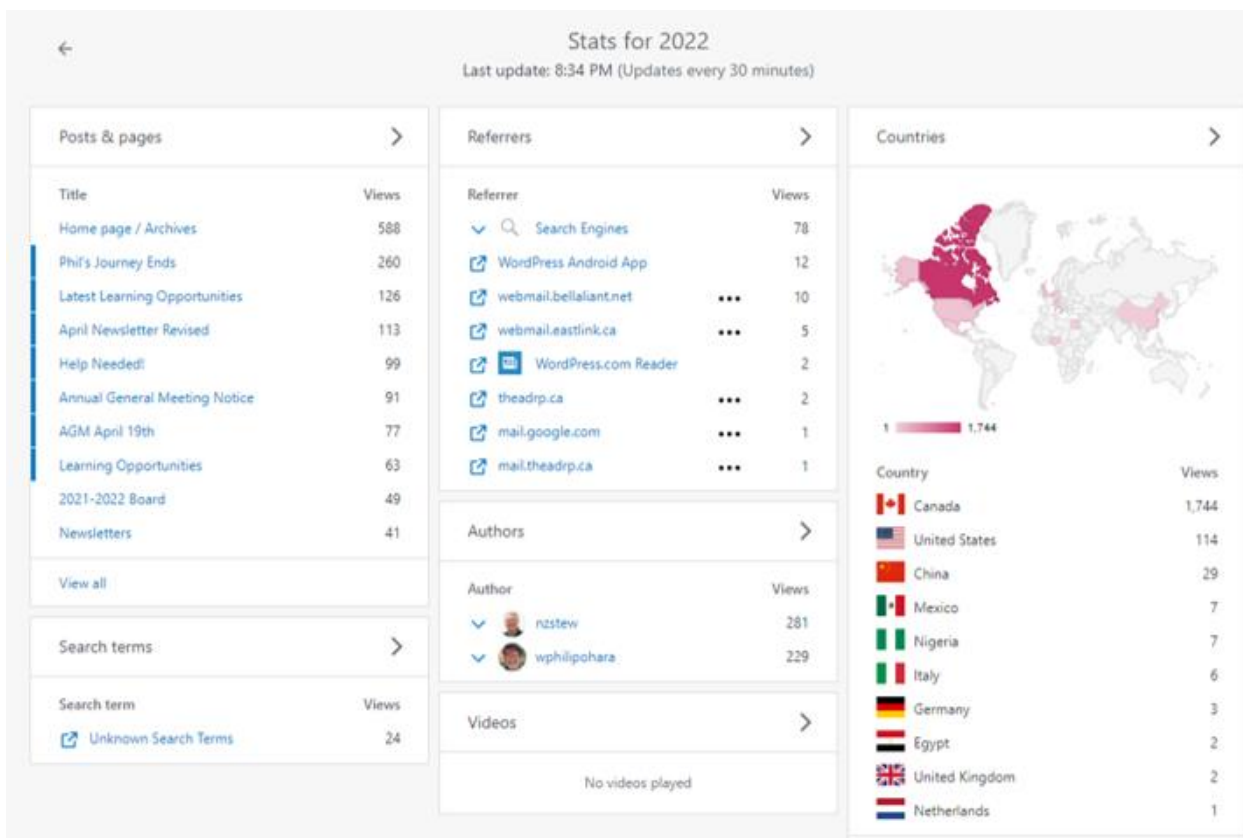
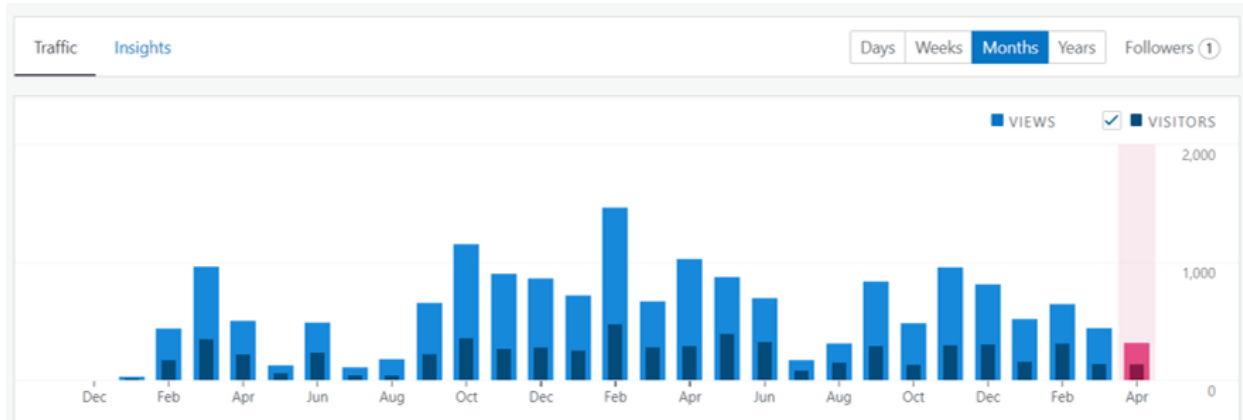




Report of the Webmaster to the AGM

April 19, 2022

1. The responsibilities for the ADRP website were shared among several members in 2021. With the untimely passing of Phil O'Hara and Glenn Shea, and the leave of David MacNeil, the webmaster duties have fallen to just one person. Most of the accounts for the necessary components have been transferred from Mr. O'Hara's ownership. A volunteer has come forward to assist: Dr. Swapan Dasgupta has had one Zoom session to orient him to the workings of the site. More are planned.
2. The work of adding previous minutes of the board and the AGMs to the website has continued. They are accessible under the "Documents and Minutes" menu.
3. The board approved the purchase of the "sister" domains *theadrp.net*, *theadrp.org* and *theadrp.com*. They were activated and validated with our web host provider. Security certificates and redirects were installed. Now, if anyone types in any of those domains in a browser, they will be redirected to our own *theadrp.ca* site. In this way we are protected against impersonation by outside parties who might try to claim these domains for themselves.
4. Through the ongoing efforts of Susan Holmes, we have added two new pages that have proven very popular. One is a listing of upcoming educational opportunities from other university retired faculty associations. The other comprises ongoing resources of potential interest to our members. I am also considering some style changes to the website to make it more colorful and more visually appealing.
5. The website has had over 17,000 views since inception with an average of 500 views monthly. 284 members are subscribers. The newsletters, educational opportunities and the news posts are most popular pages on the website. Some snapshots of visit statistics to our website follow.
